For children's parties, Kemu BOX is the ideal piñata! No fights, everyone plays and wins equally! Use it as many times as you want!

Content Of The Game



Assembled and disassembled Kemu BOX (with 15 cavities to hide gifts or challenges)



2 trays (15 circles in each one)



12 sheets of paper (to glue on the trays)



Small bag to store your challenge cards and glue stick



15 cards with fun challenges



15 blank cards for your own challenges



Glue stick (to glue the sheets)




Instruction manual

*Gifts and surprises not included. Fill your Kemu BOX with the surprises that best suit your party.


Set Up Your Kemu Box In 5 Easy Steps

Assemble the Kemu BOX:

Fold flap A inwards, inserting small flaps 1 and 2 inside. Repeat this step with flap B and small flaps 3 and 4.




Place the dividers inside the box, starting with the 2 longest ones. Fit their ends into the sides of the box (images 2.1 and 2.2). Align the slots of the long dividers with the slots of the shorter ones (images 2.3 and 2.4).




Let the fun begin!

Remember to put as many surprises as players will participate!


You can insert one or more surprises for each player. You decide how to fill the cavities: only with gifts or with challenges that they will have to overcome if they want to hit again to get their gift. 3 Glue the sheet onto the tray.
Be sure to apply glue around all the circles so that it sticks well.



Glue application



- **Fill the 15 cavities** inside your Kemu BOX with gifts or fun challenges.
- 5 Place the holetray lined with paper on top of the dividers and close your Kemu BOX.



How to Use The Challenges

You can add more excitement and fun to the game by filling your Kemu BOX not only with gifts for all participants, but also with **challenges** they will have to overcome if they want to hit again.

Put your guests to the challenge! Each challenge test their skill, strength or ingenuity.

Inside your Kemu BOX we propose you some of them, but you can give free rein to

your imagination and create new and fun challenges for your guests (use the blank cards to do so).


Fold the cards in half before using them, to prevent them from moving from one cavity to another!



Start the Game!

- Place your Kemu BOX on a flat, stable surface or hold it in the air. Depending on the participants' strength and enthusiasm, it should be held by one or two people.
- Players line up in front of the Kemu BOX, starting with the youngest participant or following the chosen order.
- The first player hits a circle! tearing the paper to discover their surprise. If it's a gift, their turn is over; if it's a challenge, they have to overcome it to hit again.

- 4. The player continues their turn until they find their **gift.**
- 5. Then, it's the next player's turn.
- 6. The game ends when all players have hit a circle and received their gift.

Variants of the Game

From 15 to 30 players

If there are more than 15 players or you want to hit your Kemu BOX more than 15 times in the same event:

After breaking the 15 paper circles in the first tray, you can refill the box with surprises or challenges. Then, place the second tray of holes still unbroken inside your Kemu BOX and continue the game!

After Using the 2 Trays

- 1. Remove the leftover paper from the cardboard trays (with all the circles already broken).
- 2. Glue one of the replacement sheets that are included with the game (you have 10 sheets to use).
- 3. And... the fun continues!

More than 30 players

If there are 30 players or more... No problem!

Up to 30 players can participate using the 2 trays that come with your Kemu BOX (each with 15 circles to break). But if there are more players or you want to use more cavities to include more gifts or challenges for each participant, we explain how.

Acquiring Additional Trays

If you wish, you can buy new trays and sheets on our website.



How to Store Your Kemu BOX After the Game

After finishing the game: You can fold your Kemu BOX and store it back in its box for future games.

Tips

- Always use glue stick to glue the new sheets. Once the game is over, the excess paper can be easily removed without damaging the tray.
- If you put several small gifts in each cavity, give a small bag to each player before starting the game to speed up the game.
- If you are going to introduce very thin or very small objects (such as papers or stickers), keep in mind that they can move from one cavity to another inside the box once it is closed and placed vertically. To avoid this, we recommend that you place them in a small bag or container beforehand

Possible uses of your Kemu BOX

Your Kemu BOX can be adapted to any event: birthdays, weddings, bachelor/bachelorette parties, corporate/Team Building events, baby showers... or just a fun party with friends and family!

Depending on the type of event, you can choose from several models.

But if you are looking for something unique and customizable, the **Kemu Maker** model is the ideal choice! This model, white on the outside, allows you to decorate it your way: draw, add stickers, photos... whatever you can think of! Let your creativity run wild and customize it to reflect your style or surprise the person you are honoring.

Use under adult supervision is recommended.
